To whom it may concern,

We are looking for help for teenagers to attend Fusion Camp, a teen camp hosted at Eastern Mennonite University in Harrisonburg, Virginia this summer (July 11-15, 2016). Last year we took over 40 students to camp and this year that number is expected to exceed over 50.

The students are hosting a spaghetti dinner Saturday, April 30th, to help raise funds. During this dinner we have also added a Silent Auction. Over the last few years we have had businesses donate for this auction and it has helped to provide funds for teens to go to camp. The money from the auction is divided up between those students who work the dinner and is applied to their camp fundraising account (Camp cost per student is \$285).

We use the church budget to pay for all supplies used in the dinner and to pay for leaders going to camp, so **all the money raised from the auction actually goes to students who will be attending camp.**

There are two ways that you can help us in getting students to camp. First, you may donate new items for us to auction off. **Your business will be seen by over 250 people who will come to the auction/dinner.** You may rather donate cash/check to help teens instead of items. We will keep track of all of donations and cash gifts and will let the people who attend the dinner know that your business helped us with funding students to attend camp, through both PowerPoint and Table Ad Cards. The PowerPoint will be projected in the gym (where the dinner will be) on two walls and 4 flat screen TVs. Your company logo will appear about every 3 minutes on one each of these media devices at random times.
